Gregoire, yet another tasty addition to the Gourmet Ghetto, gained a quick reputation for serving delicious California-style take-out with a conscience. Food is seasonal, organic when possible and grown by local farmers.

While dinner prices are moderate, lunch is a bargain when you consider the quality of ingredients. The menu changes monthly and includes mouth-watering items such as shredded pork and applesauce on ciabatta (\$6.50), roasted leg of lamb with garlic cream on a baguette (\$7.50), and baby spinach with feta cheese, pine nuts and grilled chicken (\$7.50).
